5. Aims and Objects:

The aims and objects for which Society is established shall be as under:

1. To Provide Govt. policy of right of education to every children of age of 3 years and above.
2. To establish and promote educational activities to the children of age of 3 years and above.
3. To establish schools in the rural belts from Nursery to Secondary level and get them affiliated to concerning Boards .
4. To promote Educational facilities to all sections of the society and more efforts will direct to the underprivileged, weaker sections and backward classes.
5. To encourage, promote, develop sports as basic means of education through Nursery section and thereon to the secondary sections.
6. To promote a representative and centralized body or organization to collect , coordinate and distribute data, ideas, knowledge, methods and techniques by any suitable means pertaining to the awareness and development of academic with sports activities.
7. To make surveys, studies, world networking conferences, symposia, educative seminars, training workshops and forums arrange for the presentation of lectures and papers on matters and problems of interest to foster, promote, encourage and facilitate discussion, study and research on matters and problems to academic and sports activities and generally to collect and disseminate, in any manner deemed appropriate in formation of service or interest to its members or the public at large.
8. To hunt for talent in the rural and urban society for which certain hidden treasure will not be wasted for want of certain basic needs in the field of academic and sports.
9. To arrange, highlight , encourage, develop the promising sports children in the streets , schools, play school to hold sports meet at school.

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10. Provide un biased and equal opportunities to the candidates with disability at par with others and also enhance employment opportunities for qualified candidate with disabilities.
11. To establish training institutes for up gradation of skills of the persons with disabilities.
12. To provide clean and hygienic environment, the collective management and use of those gifts of nature, so necessary for human life, water and pasture.
13. Provide organic manure, which enriched the soil, improve village hygiene through the effective disposal of waste and enhanced crop yields.
14. Encourage rain harvesting and plantation of more and more trees for healthier and green environment.
15. Introduce some special schemes for the treatment and rehabilitation of women with acid attacks and victims.
16. Provide counseling for regainment of social status in respect to the rape victims.

19. To promote Medical/Health Institutions Scientific/Research Institutions. To Establish and Run Nursing Homes, Hospital, Medical Educational and Research Centers Medical Colleges, Nursing Institutions, health Sports/Centers, and Medicinal and Hygienic capable units.
20. To promote Educational Facilities and bring them to the reach of poor and back ward classes as far as Possible.
21. To promote literacy, Cultural and other Activities by awareness programmers, adult Education Classes, lectures, Eassy competitions, Exhibitions, Cultural programmers, pres conference and Seminars.

27. That there will be no infringement to the proviso to the section 2/(15) of the IT Act.

31. To society shall be non- profitable society and all its acts/Activities shall be done on " No Profit No Loss Basis".










RULES AND REGULATIONS OF

"KANTA RANI EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY "

1. MEMBERSHIP :-

The membership of the society is open to any person or persons who has attained the age of majority and fulfils the terms and conditions of the society, without any incrimination of the religion, caste, color or creed, but subject to the approval of the governing body. If the membership is refused to a person, the reason for refusal shall be communicate to the person concerned.

2. SUBSCRIPTION :-

Admission fee Rs.500/-at the time of admission..

3. TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP

The governing body shall have the power to expel a member from the society on the following grounds :-

- a) By no confidence motion passed by 2/3rd majority of votes of members present and voting in general body meeting.
- b) On this /her death.
- c) Non payment of subscription continuously for three months from the due date.
- d) On his/her written resignation :
- e) He/she has not attended three connective meetings of the general body without any Intimation.

Noted :- The reason of termination from the membership shall be communicated to the member concerned.









4. APPEALS :-

All the appeals should be referred to the general body of the society. The decision of the general body shall be final. The reason for rejection shall be communicated to the Member concerned.

5. RE-ADMISSION :-

In case the member expelled by the governing body the same can be re-admitted provided the member concerned, pays all up to date dues.the decision of the general body shall be final.



6. GOVERNING BODY'S STRENGTH :-

The governing body shall consist of all members and office bearers as under :-

5. EXECUTIVE MEMBERS.....

7. BANK ACCOUNTS :-

The Bank account of the society shall be operated jointly by the President / Secretary/Treasurer Alongwith one out of president or any other office bearer or person so authorized by the governing body.

8. GENERAL BODY :-

All the membership of the society will constitute the general body.

8 (a) FUNCTION OF THE GENERAL BODY :-

- a) To consider any business brought forward by the governing body.
- b) There shall be an annual meeting of the general body in the months of March, every Year.
- c) Not less than 15 days notice shall be given to the members before the date of general body meeting enclosing the agenda specifying date, time and place and the quorum shall be 2/3rd.

9. SOURCES OF INCOME :-

- i) Admission fee.
- ii) Subscription.
- iii) Special contribution and donations.

Note: - All the Income of the society received from all sources shall be utilized only for the promotion and upliftment of the aims and objects of the above named society.

10. GOVERNING BODY :-

The governing body's strength shall not be less than 7 and not more than 21. The Member of the governing shall hold the office for two years. The meeting of the General body shall be held as and when necessary for which 15 days clear notice Will be required and quorum shall be 2/3rd.

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11. ELECTION AND QUORUM :-

The general body in its annual meeting will elect its president and all the office Bears and members after five years by secret ballot papers.

12. FUNCTIONS OF THE GOVERNING BODY:-

- a) To arrange finance if required from other bank (s) institution (s) or individual on reasonable terms and conditions and the governing body as a whole is liable for its return.
- b) The governing body shall make plan for the future programmers of the society.
- c) To appoint, terminate any staff.
- d) To governing body shall meet at quarterly Interval.
- e) To publish literature and to propagate the system to approach the public, pertaining to upliftment ;of status of the society.
- f) To accept donations, charities loans,grants properties etc. from public other Association, agencies and govt. or semi-govt.departments in the interest of the Interest of the promotion on the aims and objects of the society.
- g) In case the society takes the secured or unsecured loan from any financial or non-financial institution it will/ may ask the school to repay the loan according to the terms and conditions.
- h) In case if the School building and the land is given on rent to the school by the third party then the society will ensure that the school pay rent for both the school building and the land at regular interval and as per the agreement.
13. All the Income of the society shall be deposited in the nationalized bank.

13.a) The society shall maintain a register of its members giving the following particulars regarding entrance of case action of his/her membership:-

- a) Name and full address of the member.
- b) The date of birth of the member.
- c) Occupation of the member.
- d) Date of governing body meeting by which he is admitted as under.
- e) The date on which a member ceased to be such member.
- f) The date of cessation /termination of members from the society.



13. b) RIGHTS AND PREVILEGES OF THE MEMBERS :-

All and every member of the society :-

- a) The Society Shall be entitled to participate in the meetings and religious/cultural functions and other lawful gathering called/arranged by the society.
- b) Shall have right to inspect the books of accounts minutes of proceedings of the general Body meetings and the register of members of the society on any working day during business hours by giving reasonable notice.
- c) Shall be bound by the Rules and Regulations and or bye-laws which may be framed from time to time.
- d) Shall make his/her activities to promote/develop the aims and objects of the society.

13.c) FILLING UP CASUAL VACANCIES :-

VICE-PRESIDENT :-

- a) In the absence of the president the vice president shall enjoy all the powers and Duties which are entrusted to the president. He/she will also assist the president In his/her work.

14. SECRETARY/ TREASURES :-

- a) To sign on behalf of the society, to conduct it a correspondence and to record the Proceedings of meetings.
- b) To summon and attend the meetings of the general body.
- c) To call ordinary general meeting if desired on written request of a least twenty Members.
- d) He/she shall keep accounts of all the receipts and expenditures of the society and to furnish necessary information's to the governing body.
- e) He/she will keep Rs. 500/- with him and balance amount will have to be deposited In the bank.

16. TENURE :

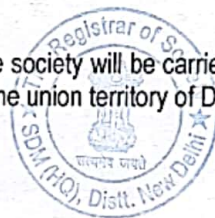
The term of the governing body shall be ² ~~five~~ years.
